Control Measures Required

- All staff to be trained in the use of chemicals used in the building, sprays, cleaners etc.
- Safety data sheets and risk assessment should be available for all chemicals used or stored and all staff and volunteers to have read and understood them.
- Personal protective equipment to be available where required, suppliers' data sheets should be followed for recommendations.
- Ensure the ground floor boiler room where some chemicals are stored is kept locked when not in use, with authorised access only.
- Try and use chemicals which are least toxic and replace with milder alternatives where possible.
- Ensure to follow the manufacturer's instructions at all times and never to transfer to another container.
- All staff to be reminded to check their hands for dry, red or itchy skin.
- COSHH assessments to be completed.
