Control Measures Required

- Ensure safe access to the lighting, i.e. changing bulbs/maintenance is carried out in a controlled, safe manner.
- Ensure young person's activities, access and organisation on the stage are controlled and supervised to prevent falling from the stage.
- Ensure that when any work is carried out to the stage/gallery, all unauthorised access is prohibited and a safe system of work is put in place. Ensure faulty electrical wiring/equipment is immediately reported.
- Ensure all costumes/clothing that is not required are removed to reduce risk.
- Ensure that all unnecessary items are removed when the stage is in use to ensure safe access/egress.
- Reduce lifting/handling furniture by mechanising or eliminating. If required, lift and assess load before moving.
