

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Study UK Radon map to check if Radon is present at property.</li> <li>• If the building is less than 25 metres in length you can order a radon address search from Public Health England (PHE) for a small fee at: <a href="http://www.ukradon.org/information/ukmaps">http://www.ukradon.org/information/ukmaps</a></li> <li>• If the building is more than 25 metres in length you can order a report from the British Geological Survey, currently costing around £44 at: <a href="http://shop.bgs.ac.uk/georeports/purpose.cfm">http://shop.bgs.ac.uk/georeports/purpose.cfm</a></li> <li>• Consider Radon detectors as a precaution.</li> <li>• Obtain professional advice to carry out a specific risk assessment as necessary</li> </ul>
