Control Measures Required

- Ensure that all staff and volunteers receive training and supervision.
- Do not put metal dishes in the microwave.
- Remove all lids from jars and takeaway containers before you put them in the microwave.
- Do not cook food in a sealed container.
- Keep the inside surfaces and the oven door clean.
- Do not use the oven if the door does not close properly.
- Take care when setting the timer cook switch.
- Food containers can be very hot use an oven cloth or oven gloves.
- Remove the cling film carefully and keep out of the way of steam.
- Never switch the oven on if it is empty.
- Ensure the PAT Testing is carried out on a yearly basis.
- Carry out visual checks before use and report any problems immediately.
- Ensure that personal protective equipment (PPE) is used.
- Provide a door leak protector and follow the manufacturer's instructions.
